- Pay \$512 a month on loan at Station 2. \$35,000 of the \$150,000 towards station 2 has been spent.
- Have \$15,779.00 left from the loan to build station 3. We borrowed \$50,000.
- Station 3 payment on loan is \$357.00 a month.
- Taking \$4,000 out of county funds to pay insurance next month.
- 304 payment: \$12,487
- 301 payment: \$1,306

NEW BUSINESS

- Pigeon Forge Fire went well other than radio communication. We paid for our fuel the first day and after that Pigeon Forge filled the trucks up with fuel.
- Station 3: Meet at station 3 on Saturday, April 23, 2022, at 10:00am for a work session and put the flagpole up. Also working on landscaping. We may go and help Mike Nutter at station 2 as well.
- Station 2: Everything needed to get started on the building is there. Chris Isaacs talked to the water department, and we are not going to dig the meters out yet. They do not have a meter for us yet.
- We have \$16,000 saved to pay for the Central Fire Department engine once it is available.
- Association meeting went well. They voted to support radio system.
- Next Association meeting is at our station. We need to decide on what food to purchase for the meeting.
- We got the two smart boards for Station 1 and Station 2 that was donated by the city schools.
- Firework order still is looking good.
- Chris Isaacs talked to Mike Nutter and expressed that we need the building at station 2 up before June 20th and Mike Nutter stated they would start working on it.
- Chris Isaacs has an electrician to set the panel and the rest of the wiring we will do at station 2.
- We will only be doing the firework fundraiser as of now. We are too busy.
- Mailouts are 8 weeks out and have been ordered.
- Check on pricing for new cash register
- Firework event at station 1: We have the DJ, Funnel cake seller coming again this year. We are going to try and setup games for the kids and get metals for them. We need to find someone to host the event. We may build an obstacle course for kids. This year, we will only be doing hot dogs and bottled water.
- Need to borrow FM transmitter or purchase one for the event.
- Meeting for May will be on the 3rd week due to association meeting. The date for that is Thursday, May 19, 2022.
- Radio System we go with depends on which system they vote for.

MEMBERSHIP

- Rusty Humphrey needs to be discussed at next meeting when more members are available to attend the meeting.
- Christian Brinkley who moved here from the Memphis area is in foster care. He wants to join the department as a junior firefighter. He did a few ride a longs in Memphis. Chris Isaacs will be working with his foster parents on getting all his paperwork complete. We don't vote for Junior members.
